Tournament Structure

1.- RULES

- ❑ The International Tournament F-11 MADRID Football Cup 2018 U14 Alcobendas Edition will be played according to the R.F.E.F. (FIFA) rules.

2.- TOURNAMENT FORMAT

- ❑ **8 groups of 4 teams** (Group A, Group B, Group C, Group D, Group E, Group F, Group G and Group H)
- ❑ The ranking in the group is determined by the highest number of points;
- ❑ 3 points for every win;
- ❑ 1 point for every draw;
- ❑ 0 points for every lost.

If two or more teams are equal on points in the completion of the group matches, the following criteria are applied to determine the ranking:

- a) Result in the game played between the teams. If are more than two teams, Higher number of points obtained in the matches played amongst the teams in question
- b) Superior goal difference from the matches played amongst the teams in question
- c) Superior goal difference from all the group matches played
- d) Higher number of goals scored in all the group matches played
- e) Less number of goals received in all group matches played
- f) Fair Play (less number of disciplinary cards)
- g) Coin

3.- CATEGORY

- ❑ Players participating in the tournament must be born after **01-01-2005**.

4.- TOURNAMENT PROGRAMATION



ROYAL TRAINING GROUP

- ❑ The group games will be played Friday 14th September 2018.
- ❑ Qualifiers games will be played Saturday 15th and Sunday 16th morning
- ❑ The Final, 3rd and 4th place and the rest of qualifiers games will be played on Sunday 16th September 2018 in the morning.

5.- GAME TIME

- ❑ The duration of the group games will be **2 x 20 minutes** with a **break of 5 minutes**.
- ❑ **Quarterfinals, semifinals, the 3rd and 4th** and classification games will consist of **2 x 20 minutes** with a **break of 5 minutes**. If at the end of the game the result is tied, it will go directly to **5 penalties**. We will continue the penalty shootout until one team failures. Only players who finish regulation time in the field can take penalty shots.
- ❑ **The Final match will consist of 2 times of 25 minutes** with a 5-minute rest period. If at the end of the game the result is tied, it will go directly to **5 penalties**. We will continue the penalty shootout until one team failures. Only players who finish regulation time in the field can take penalty shots.

6.- PLAYERS INFORMATION /SUBSTITUTIONS

- ❑ Each team must have a maximum of **20* players** for the entire tournament.
- ❑ In each match, a maximum of **18 players** can be registered.
- ❑ In each match you can make **7** changes, being able to do up to **3** of them after to start of the second half.
- ❑ The players not participating in each of the match, may sit on the bench next to the coaching staff and other substitutes, and must wear **DIFFERENT** clothing than the rest of substitute players.
- ❑ A player who has been replaced during the course of a match **is not allowed to enter get back on the field during the same game**.
- ❑ A player, who has been expelled with a direct red card during a match, **is not allowed to play next match**.
- ❑ A yellow card has no influence for next match.
- ❑ **All reclamations can be done writing to the Competition Committee until 30 min after the match played. (see point 8)**
- ❑ **The Comite of Competition is formed by 4 persons of the Organization.**
- ❑ Before the game, **each team has to present a list with the 18 players participants in the match.**

7.- REFEREES

- ❑ All referees, assistant referees and 4 referees shall be directed to the CARFFM



8.- RECLAMATIONS

At the time of the claim, the claimant must make a deposit of **50 euros** per player claimed, if the player certifies its legality by submitting any of the original documents, the field officer shall terminate the claim.

In any case if the legality of the player claimed **the claimant will lose the deposit and otherwise will be returned it demonstrated**. Complaints about refereeing errors cannot alter the outcome of the game.

Competition committee's decision is final and irrevocable. The interpretation of the facts and rules will be final and irrevocable.

9.- EQUIPMENT

- ❑ All the teams must bring a home and away kit. In the case of matching uniforms, **the team second mentioned in the match program will be designated to change clothes**.
- ❑ Each player needs to wear the same kit number during the whole tournament.

10.- REQUIRED PAPERWORK IN EACH MATCH

- ❑ The team manager or coordinator of the teams needs to handout the list of names and numbers to the referee 30 minutes before kickoff.
- ❑ A game cannot start without handing out the list of names to the referee.

11.- TIMELINESS

- ❑ The program will be completed in accordance with the mentioned times. The teams who are not present 5 minutes after the beginning of a match, will lose that match with 3 - 0.

12.- STAFF

- ❑ All teams **will get a coordinator during the tournament** that will assist the teams with questions, logistics and their schedule.
- ❑ All players, coaches or representatives of the teams **must wear his accreditation** in the Tournament, **to avoid access problems**.

- Any circumstance that has not been reflected in the regulations is exclusive competence of those responsible for the Organization, being their final decision, reserving the right to add, interpret, modify and apply the rules according to their criteria and the needs of the tournament.

Within the aforementioned facilities, teams will have areas for the pre-game warm-up and a wardrobe in all matches.
